INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- ❑ Plug the keyboard into the PC
- ❑ Use the CD to install the software
(alternatively download the software from www.spartangear.eu)
- ❑ Once you complete the installation, right click the icon  that will appear on your desktop and click open

PROGRAMMING INSTRUCTIONS

You can program and customize up to 3 different profiles. Keys function programming and light customization instructions are the same for Profile 1, Profile 2 and Profile 3.

Key Assignment feature

- 1 Roll over the keyboard and click any key you want to program.
- 2 Enter the keystroke you wish to replace the selected key with and/or tick any of the boxes below to add a combined key function. You can choose up to 3, such as Ctrl+Alt+A.

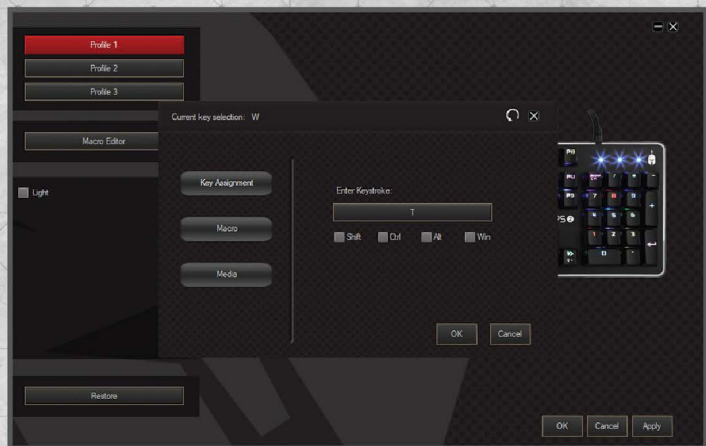
Example (1) Replace a key with another single key

- ❑ Select a key, for example “W”
- ❑ Click “Key Assignment”
- ❑ Type “T” and click “OK”
- ❑ Click “Apply” when you complete the programming to save
- ❑ “W” and any other programmed key will appear with a red border line

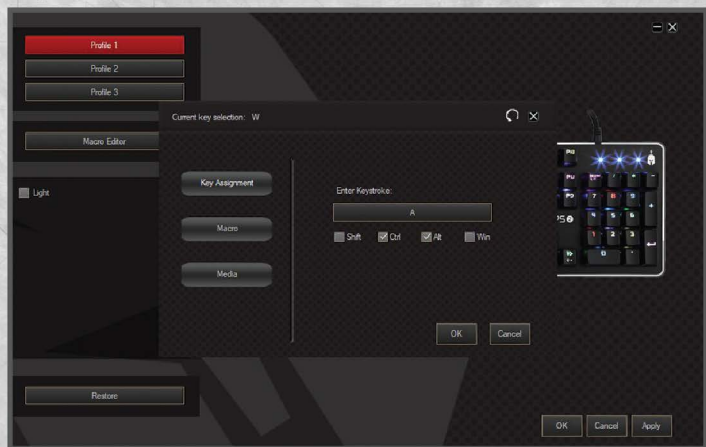
Example (2) Replace a key with a key combination

- ❑ Select a key, for example “W”
- ❑ Click “Key Assignment”
- ❑ Type “A”, tick the “Ctrl” box & the “Alt” box and click “OK”
- ❑ Click “Apply” when you complete the programming to save
- ❑ “A” and any other programmed key will appear with a red border line

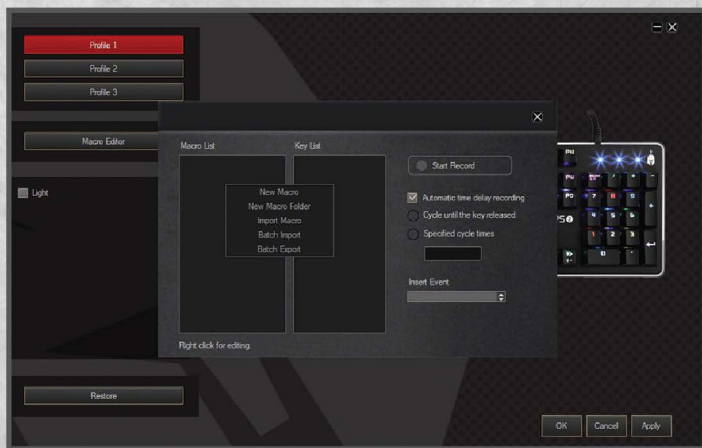
Macro feature

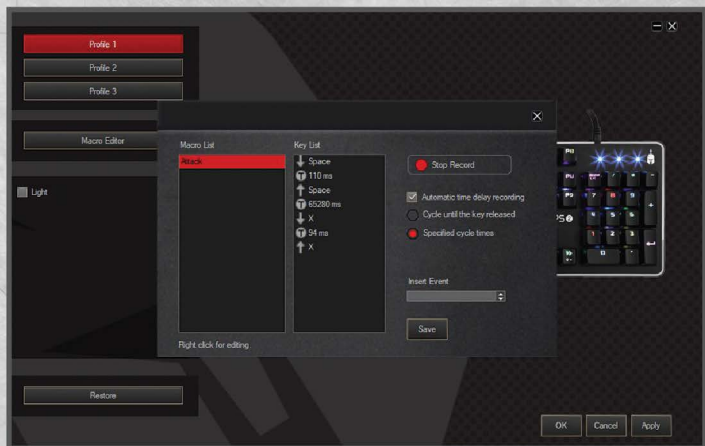
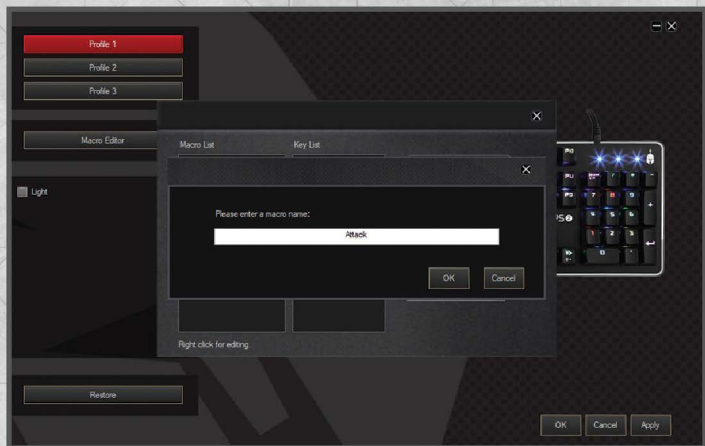
To use the “Macro” feature, first you need to set up macros on “Macro Editor”.

How to create a macro on “Macro Editor”

- ❑ Click “Macro Editor”
- ❑ Right click in the “Macro List” section and choose “New macro”
- ❑ Enter a name of your choice for the macro, for example “Attack”, and click “OK”
- ❑ Select the name of the macro and click “Start Record”
- ❑ Type the key combination you want to create the macro for. The keys will record and appear on “Key list” along with time data
- ❑ When you complete your selection click “Stop Record”
- ❑ Change the cycle time on “Specified Cycle Times” if needed
- ❑ Click “Save”

You can add as many macros as you need.



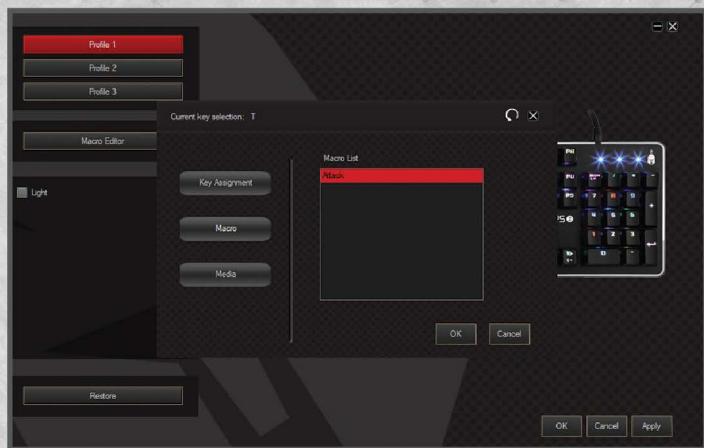


To delete any macro

- Select the macro from the “Macro List”
- Right click on it and choose “Delete”

How to assign a macro to a key

- ❑ Roll over the keyboard and click any key you want to assign to a macro, for example “T”
- ❑ Click “Macro”
- ❑ Select the macro of your choice from the “Macro List”, for example “Attack”
- ❑ Click “OK”
- ❑ Click “Apply” when you complete the macro assignment
- ❑ “T” and any other programmed key will appear with a red border line



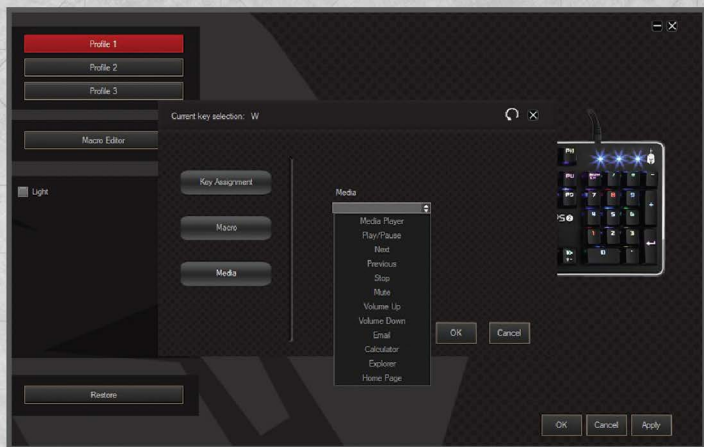
To restore keyboard function to its default settings

- ❑ Click the “Restore” button

Media feature

- ❑ Roll over the keyboard and click any key you want to assign to a media function, for example “W”
- ❑ Click “Media”

- ❑ Select the function of your choice from the “Media” list, for example “Pause/Play”
- ❑ Click “OK”
- ❑ Click “Apply” when you complete the key assignment
- ❑ “W” and any other programmed key will appear with a red border line



To restore keyboard function to its default settings

- ❑ Click the “Restore” button

LED Light programming

To enable lighting feature and programming, select the “Light” option.

Default LED light combinations

- ❑ Choose between 13 different LED light combinations from the drop-down list



□ Adjust, if needed, their Brightness and/or Speed from the bars



- ❑ For a random multicolor light combination, leave “Random Color” box selected
- ❑ For a single-color light, deselect the “Random Color” box and click the colored square on top to choose a color of your choice



Customized LED light combinations

To customize the lighting, select “Game Mode” from the drop-down list. You can choose any existing gaming color pattern from the “Color Group” menu or you can create your own color pattern by matching any key to the color of your choice.

Color option

Choose “Color” option to assign a color to one key at a time.

- ❑ Click the box under the “Color” option
- ❑ Select the color of your choice and click any key or keys you want to apply it
- ❑ The selected key or keys will now appear with the chosen color

- ❑ Repeat the same process to apply a different color to any other key or keys

- To change the color of a key

- ❑ Click on the key to remove the previously assigned color
- ❑ Choose another color and click again the key to assign

Basic Color option

Choose “Basic Color” option to assign a color to all keys at the same time.

- ❑ Click the box under the “Basic Color” option
- ❑ Select the color of your choice and click “OK”
- ❑ All the keys will now appear with the chosen color

To remove or change the color of a key

- ❑ Click on the key to remove the assigned color
- ❑ Choose another color from the “Color” option and click again the key to assign

To restore keyboard light function to its default settings

- ❑ Click the “Restore” button
